## Soldiers Certify in Sling Load Inspection

More than 30 personnel from Fort Bragg, N.C., were certified in the one-week Sling Load Inspectors Course in June.

The Sling Load Office from Fort Lee's Aerial Delivery and Field Service Department conducts the SLIC. It trains and certifies personnel from the Active and Reserve components of the Army, Marines, Navy and Air Force.

Students learn to prepare, rig and inspect supplies and equipment for sling load under rotary wing aircraft. They also learn to select, prepare and control pickup zones and landing zones during sling load operations.

The class was hosted by the 11th Quartermaster Company, 82nd Airborne Division, Fort Bragg, and was taught
